

DIY GUIDE: Make A Postcard

When we talk about postcards, both the front and the back are of great importance, as both sides come together to tell a story. Oftentimes, the senders would pick postcards with images that corresponded to their message and the person they were sending the postcard to. Think of the postcard describing the Band Stand for example.

Here is a really quirky front of a postcard!

Time to make a postcard for a special someone!

You will need:

A piece of paper to print the postcard on
A pair of scissors
Glue
Pen or pencil
A phone with camera

STEP 1

Think of someone you would like to send a postcard to. It can be a family member or a friend. Now think of things they like - it could be their favourite snack, a place they like to visit, etc. Make sure it is something you can take a picture of.

STEP 2

Take a picture of this chosen item.

STEP 3

With the help of a grown up, cut out the templates attached and stick them together. Remember to keep the print side up.

STEP 4

Stick the photograph on the side without any text, make sure to print and cut it to size.

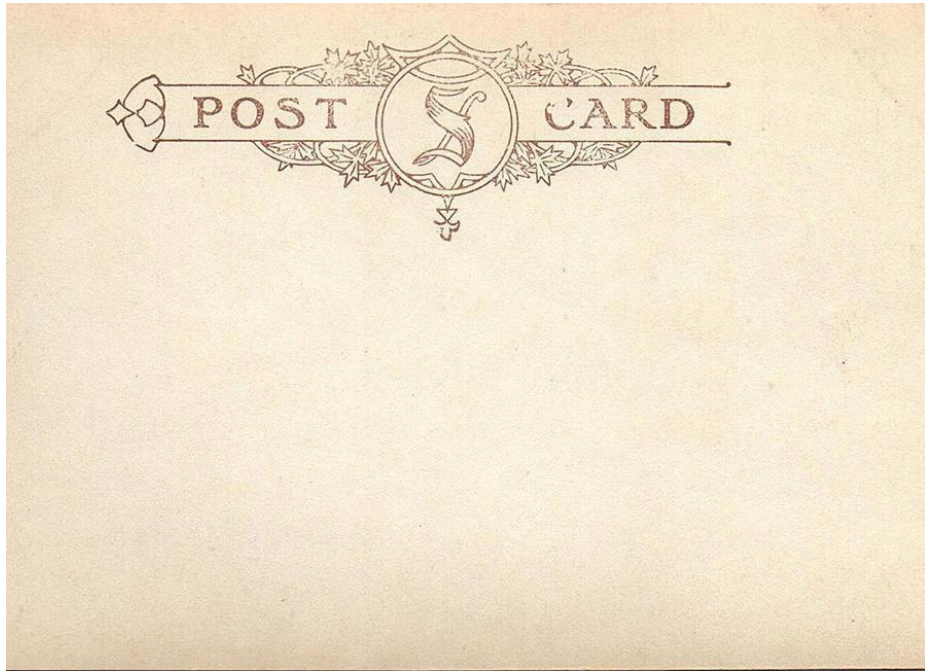
STEP 5
